



COVID SAFETY AT PROJECT CHALLENGE

Register With Reassurance - Attend With Confidence

Management Events Limited, the organisers of Project Challenge strictly adhere to all national and local government regulation and guidance on Covid safety.

Our aim is to provide a Covid-safe environment for all attendees and exhibitors.

We have worked closely with The QEII Centre to ensure that its measures are aligned with the leading event industry standards. We are happy to confirm that the venue has successfully met the criteria for two major accreditations, the Meetings Industry Association '**AIM Secure**' accreditation and Visit Britain's '**We're Good to Go**'.

During Project Challenge Expo the following procedures will be in place:

Arrival and Registration:

The QEII Centre will require all visitors to show evidence of one of the following:

- 1) Proof of double vaccination no less than 14 days before attendance (displayed via the NHS app or NHS website or for international visitors, the equivalent from their country of origin.)

or

- 2) A negative lateral flow test dated within 48 hours of attendance (reported on the Government website & displayed via text or via the NHS app.

On arrival delegates are kindly asked to use the hand sanitisers located in the entrance

A thermal imaging camera is located in the entrance to assess body temperature. Any Project Challenge Expo show attendee with a temperature over 100.4 F, 38.0 C will not be permitted to enter as this indicates a possible fever.

During the Event:

- We recommend delegates carry out regular 20 second hand washes.
- Delegates are encouraged to cover their face with a mask when in busy public areas. This is for the safety and confidence of all.
- In the Project Challenge exhibition hall (level 3) wearing face masks is optional.

Enhanced Venue Safety Measures:

- The venue is committed to the highest standards of sanitation and cleanliness, with continuous cleaning throughout the Project Challenge event.
- Personal hygiene stations will be available across the venue and airflow will be enhanced.
- Venue teams will ensure all spaces and touch surfaces are regularly sanitised e.g. door handles, push plates, stair rails, lift call buttons etc.
- Regular Clorox deep clean will be deployed for rooms, furniture and equipment
- Sneeze screens will be provided at reception and registration areas
- Each item stored in the cloakroom will be placed in its own clear biodegradable and eco-friendly garment bag to avoid contamination
- Additional hygiene measures are in place in the venue toilets; with hand sanitiser and disposable seat covers
- All venue staff have undergone extensive online health and safety training on the revised procedures in preparation for the return of events to the QE11.
- All staff will have their temperature taken by a thermal camera at the staff entrance
- All staff members present a negative lateral flow test to gain entry to the site
- All staff will wear a face covering when in public areas or will clearly display a lanyard detailing exemption
